



PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING INFORMATION (ARTT. 13 E 14 REG. UE 2016/679)

For the purposes set by the EU Regulation 2016/679 on the protection of personal data of natural persons, the Data Controller informs you that:

The processing of personal data provided by you and/or acquired by our Company also through third parties will be processed in compliance with the regulations provided for by the aforementioned Regulation in compliance with the rights and obligations that follow.

1. **PURPOSE OF THE TREATMENT** – The processing of the data requested by you or which will be communicated to us by you or by third parties can have the following purposes:
 - Execution of legal and fiscal obligations (invoicing, obligatory accounting records and records, payments);
 - Execution of contractual obligations - therefore execution of the health service, (provision of services, professional mandate);In the execution of these services, the writing company becomes aware, with the specific consent of the interested party, also of data that the European Regulation defines "relating to health", providing for greater attention to their conservation, archiving and treatment in general.
2. **METHODS OF PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA** – The processing of personal data acquired by the undersigned company is processed, with and without the aid of electronic tools, and consists of the collection, registration, organization, storage, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, blocking, communication, cancellation and destruction of data.

 - to the Salute 53 srl healthcare facility, appointed by Diagnostica 53 srl as external data processor.
 - to any public bodies or administrative authorities also following inspections and checks;
 - other companies with which there are collaborative relationships and, in any case, provided with a specific contract of external data processor.

The companies that perform outsourcing services have been designated external data processors.

In any case, they will not be disseminated in any way.

4. **CONFIRMATION OF DATA AND REFUSAL** – The provision of personal data, common and related to your state of health as well as the release for authorization to the aforementioned communications referred to in point 3 are essential for the performance of the activities referred to in point 1 and their refusal makes it impossible to perform the requested service in full.
5. **TRANSFER OF DATA ABROAD** – The personal data we acquire are not transferred to third countries with respect to the European Union.
6. **RETENTION OF DATA** – The data are kept for the period necessary to carry out all the activities related to the service offered, in accordance with the law. The owner reserves the right to evaluate a longer duration of conservation in case of need for defensive and judicial purposes.
7. **HOLDER OF THE TREATMENT** – The data controller is Diagnostica 53 s.r.l., in the person of its legal representative in office, with registered office in Azzano Decimo, viale I° maggio, 65 D / E. The internal data processor is mr. Michele Boz electively domiciled for the position at the company's registered office.

9. **RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY** – Pursuant to the European Regulation 2016/679 the interested party has the right:
 - access, rectification, cancellation, limitation and opposition to the processing of data;
 - to obtain, without hindrance from the data controller, the data in a structured format commonly used and readable by an automatic device to transmit them to another data controller;
 - to oblivion and data portability;
 - the withdrawal of consent at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the treatment based on consent given before the withdrawal;
 - to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor Authority for the protection of personal data.
